Callington Primary School Uniform Policy

It is the position of Governing Council that wearing a school uniform reflects highly on the school and its students. We are proud of our school and want to communicate this pride and sense of belonging.

Parents and caregivers are expected to support the student's wearing of the school uniform.

What is the Uniform?

The uniform is defined as the following:

- bottle green shirt (short or long sleeved)
- School windcheater/hoodie jumper
- Baseball jacket (yellow & green)
- Gingham (checked) green school dress
- Bottle green, black or charcoal grey shorts, skirt/skorts, track or school pants.
- School bucket or wide-brimmed hat in green or green & gold. Students are required to wear hats in Term 1 & 4.

Uniform items (including shoes) should allow students to participate in a wide variety of activities, including physical activity and therefore need to be comfortable and practical and a suitable length – the student must be able to stand upright, with their arms to their side and the tips of their fingers touching the bottom of their shorts/skirt/skort.

School uniform items are readily available for purchase at the school.
