



Callington Primary School Mobile Phone Policy

Date of issue – March 2020

Introduction

The preference of the school is that students DO NOT have mobile phones at school. However, it is appreciated that in some special cases, access to a mobile phone is necessary.

The school has a communication system in place that is able to deal with emergencies. Data such as parent/carers phone numbers and emergency contacts are kept up to date and are readily accessible when required.

Concerns

Concerns about students having mobile phones at school include:

- Students using phones in class create a distraction to teachers and other students.
- The inappropriate use of phones including being used to harass others.
- Students being able to make calls without supervision.
- Taking photographs of others or recording audio
- The chances of phones being damaged, lost or stolen.

Guidelines for Students and Parents/Carers

Students are not permitted to bring mobile phones to school.
Students who need to have a mobile phone at school must:

- Supply a written explanation from their parents to the Principal outlining the reason why they need to have a mobile phone at school. This explanation can be supplied via the form: "Students with Mobile Phones at School - Parent/Carer Explanation". It needs to include that the school take no responsibility for damage, loss or theft of the phone whilst in the student's possession.
- Ensure that the phone is switched off and handed to their teacher on arriving at school. Then collect the phone at the end of the school day.
- Ensure that the phone is not used on school grounds before or after school.
