We had very pleasing response to our first session of *Tuning into kids* this week, with over 20 Parents / Carers in attendance. Our Governing Council have supported this initiative with an investment of their Parents in Education grant to supply dinner and a creche. As the program continues we can share some of the key messages in upcoming newsletters.
