
Principal's Report

Dear Families,

Many families have accessed our lunch heating service we have started this term. On **Tuesdays, Wednesdays** and **Thursdays** this term, children can bring their lunch wrapped in aluminium foil, labelled with permanent texta. Trays are ready at the servery window near the staffroom for students to put their lunch on when they arrive. Food is then refrigerated and then heated in the pie warmer later in the day for children to collect at lunch time. This service does not include microwaving lunches and please ensure items aren't frozen. Please ensure you follow these guidelines so food doesn't have to be handled and this remains an efficient service for our school staff to offer.

Our annual Book week/Book Fair is next week. We recently sent out a program for the week. We look forward to seeing our families at our Family Day on Tuesday 20th August and the parade on Friday 23rd August. Our SSOs have done an amazing job setting up for the Book Fair in the library too. This year's theme is 'Reading is my Secret Power'. 
