Callington Primary School Uniform Policy

Updated May 2025 – approved by GC 22/5/25

Due for update May 2027

Rationale

At our school, uniforms help build a strong sense of **care, connection, and courage**.

Wearing a uniform, shows that we care about ourselves, each other, and our school. It helps us feel connected as part of one team, where everyone belongs and gives us the courage to be proud of who we are and to focus on learning and growing together.

They support a safe, respectful, and inclusive school environment for all.

Parents and caregivers are expected to support the student's wearing of the school uniform.

What is the Uniform?

The uniform is defined as the following:

- bottle green shirt (short or long sleeved)
- School windcheater/hoodie jumper
- Baseball jacket (yellow & green)
- Gingham (checked) green school dress
- Bottle green, black or charcoal grey shorts, skirt/skorts, track or school pants.
- School bucket or wide-brimmed hat in green or green & gold. Students are required to wear hats in Term 1 & 4 (and as deemed necessary by leadership in Terms 2 and 3 when the UV levels are 3 or higher).

School uniform items are readily available for purchase at the office (new or second hand for a gold coin donation).

Specific details

Uniform items (including shoes) should allow students to participate in a wide variety of activities, including physical activity and therefore need to be comfortable, practical and a suitable length. Uniform and tidy presentation are not only to instil pride and belonging but to ensure safety and optimal learning conditions. Therefore, please address the following (and see pictures below):

Shorts/skirts/skorts: for girls, length should be long enough to reach halfway down the thigh (uniform shop skorts and shorts acceptable) and bike shorts to be worn underneath uniform not as an outer garment

Shoes: enclosed heel and toe (no crocs, thongs, slides or similar) and black or white if possible

Socks: short and plain coloured (e.g. black, white, grey)

Jewellery: only simple earrings (e.g. studs and sleepers) and simple watches

Make up: no make up is to be worn to school

Hair: to be neat, tidy and away from the face for ease of learning and to decrease the spread of lice.


